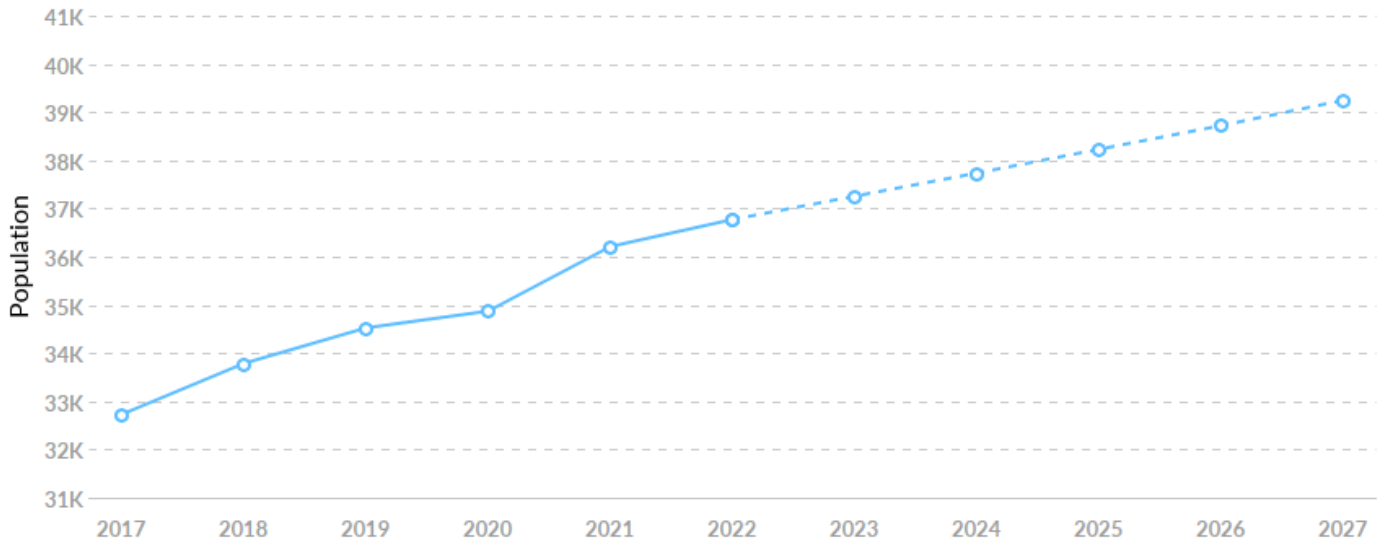

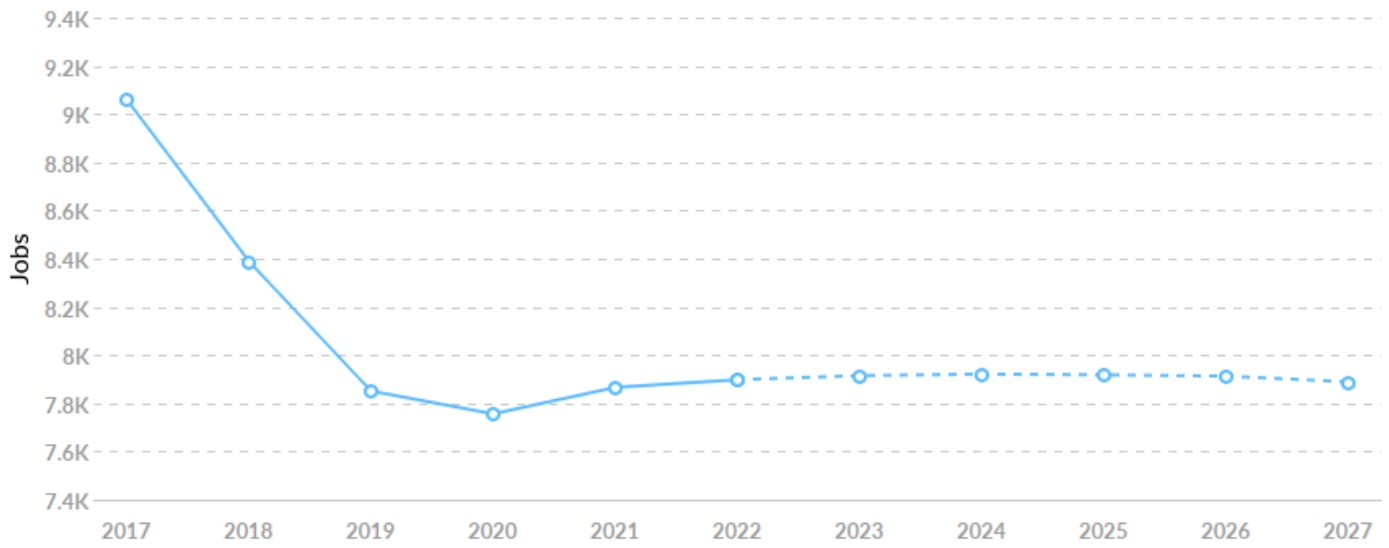

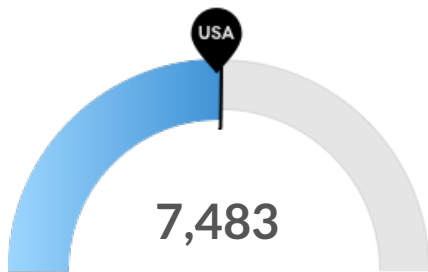
Job Trends

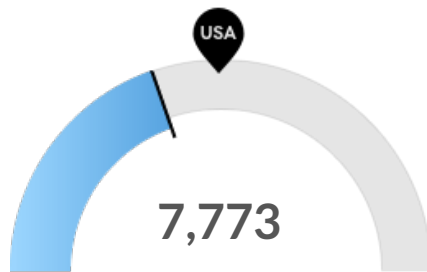

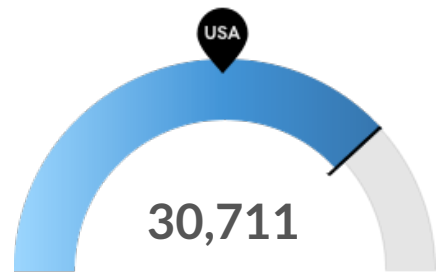
Millennials

Your area has 7,483 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 7,396.



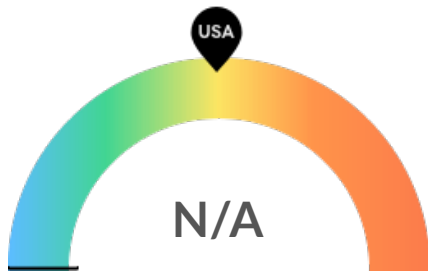
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is low in your area. The national average for an area this size is 10,763 people 55 or older, while there are 7,773 here.



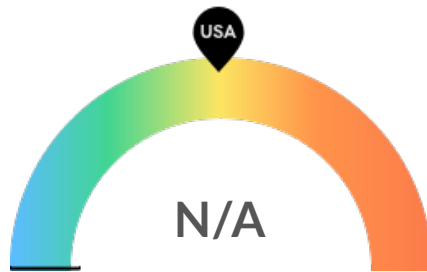
Racial Diversity

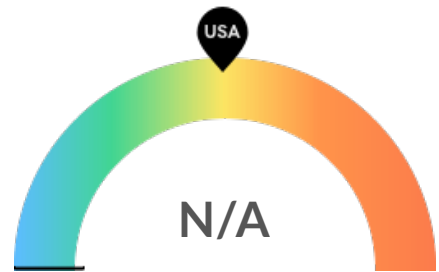

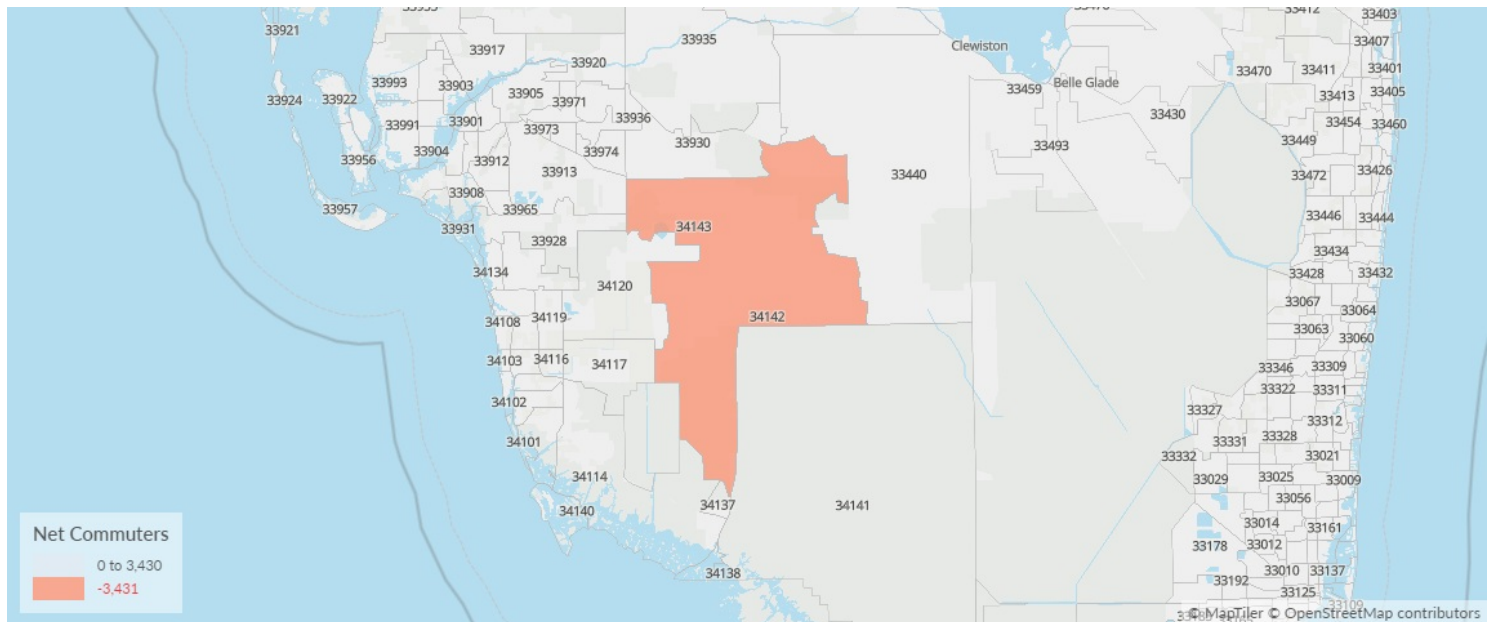

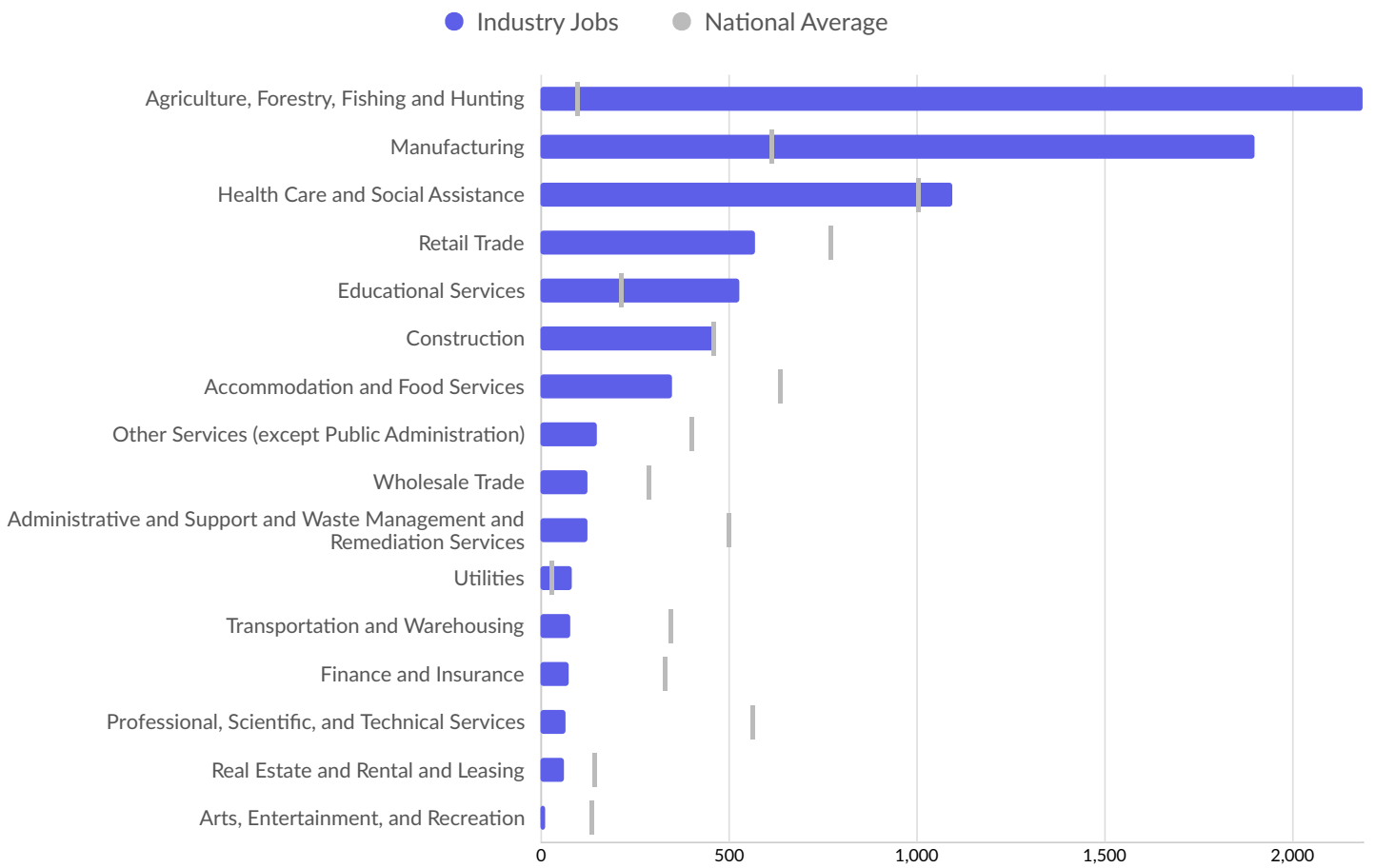

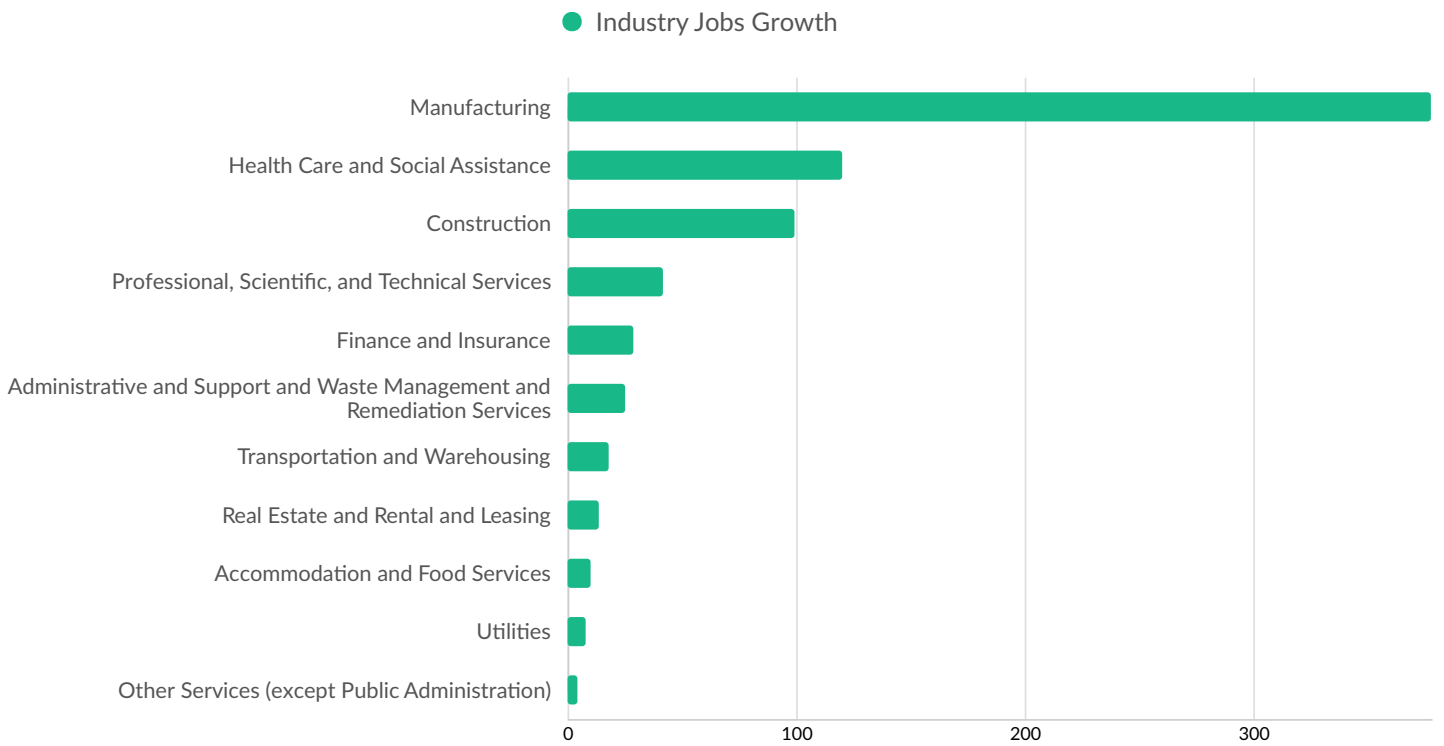

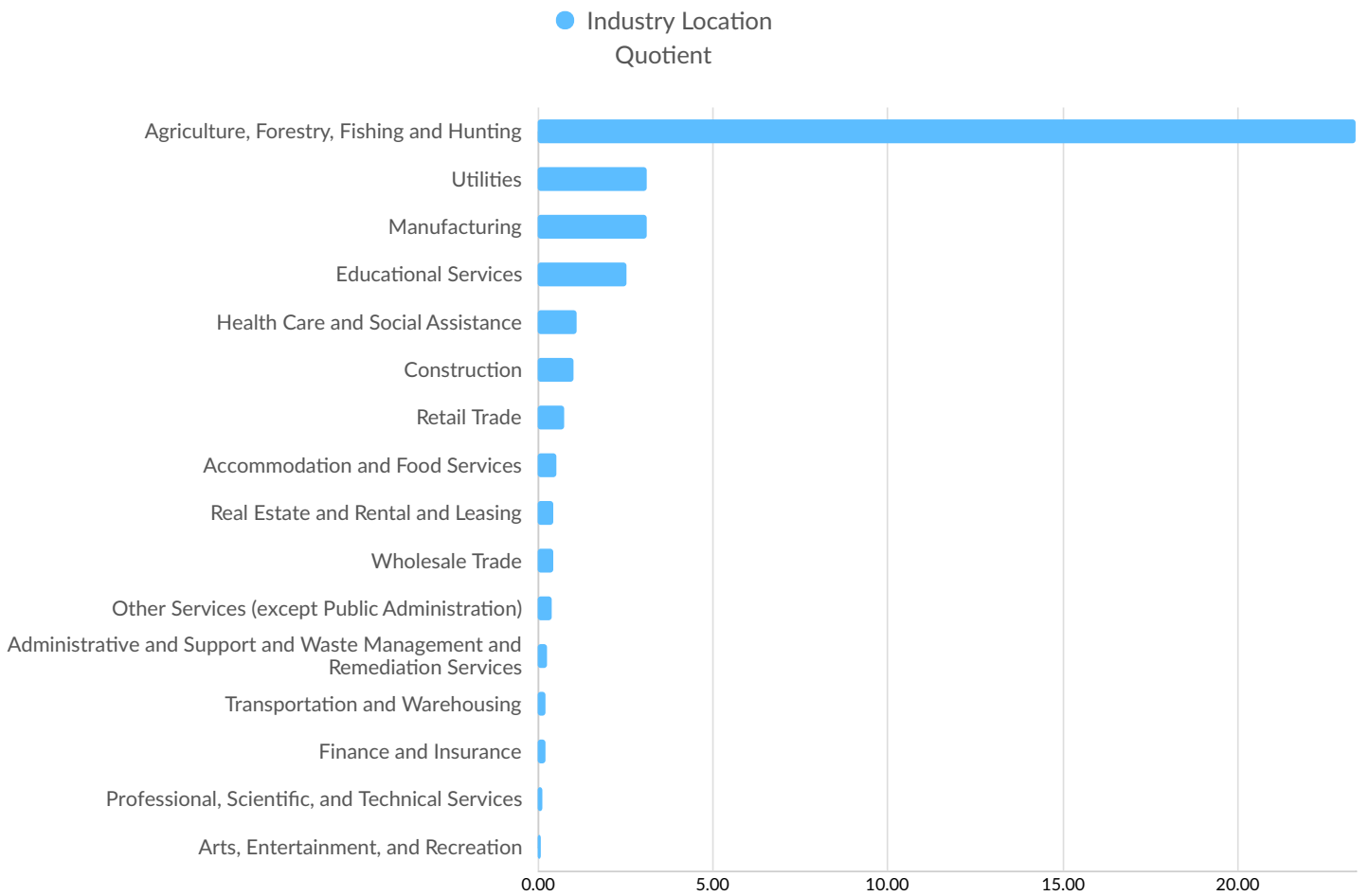

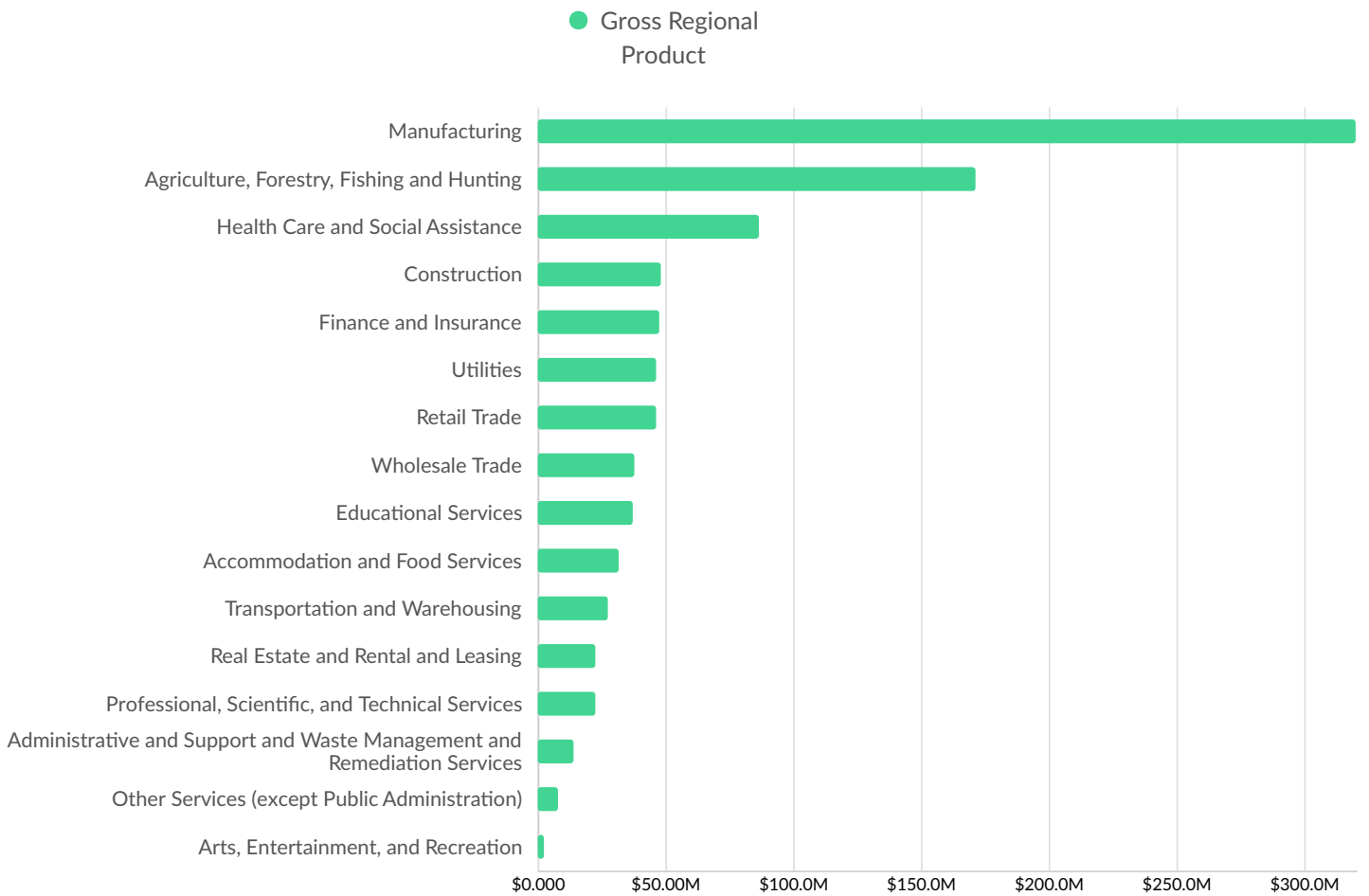
Top Growing Industries



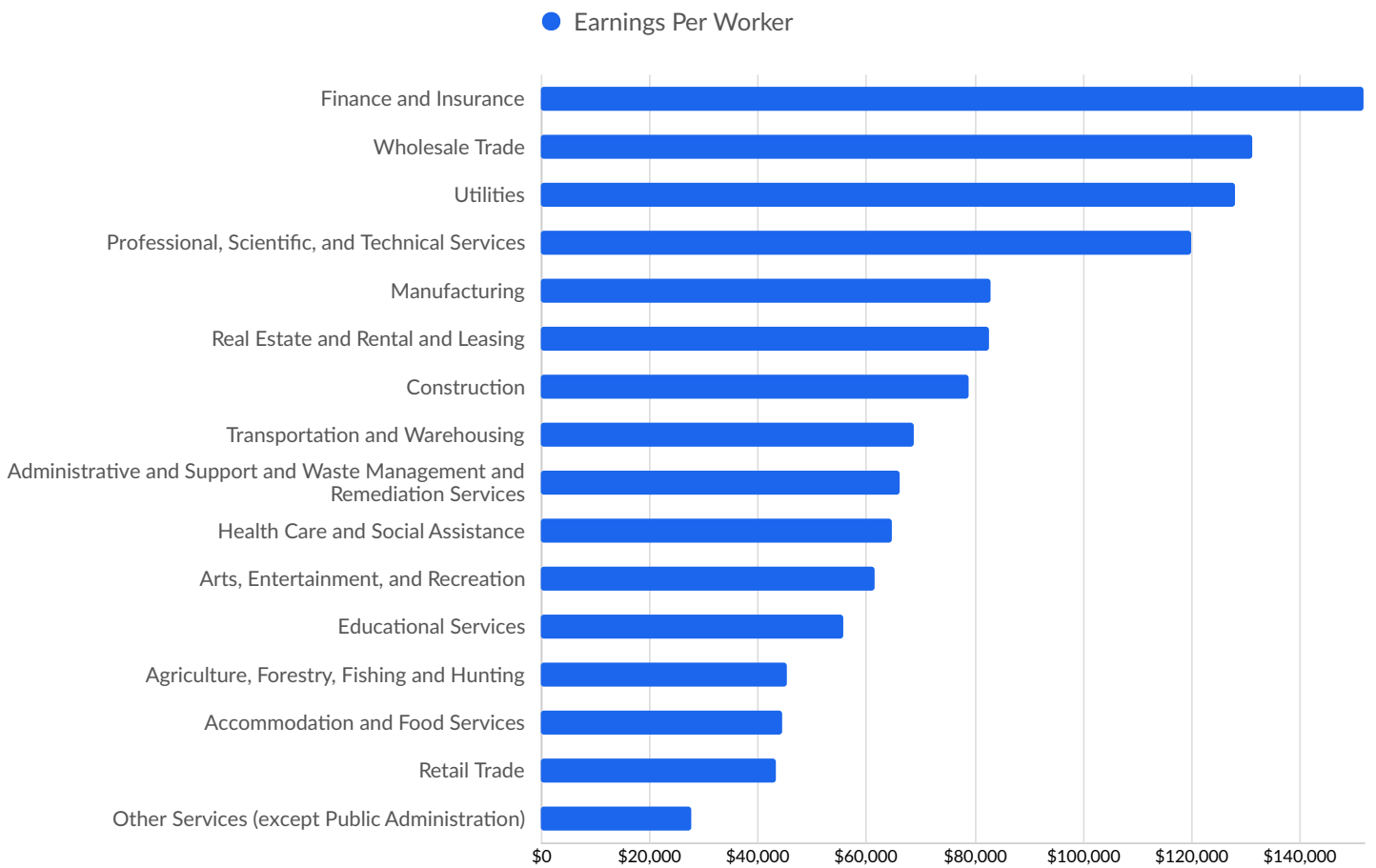
Top Industry Location Quotient



Top Industry GRP

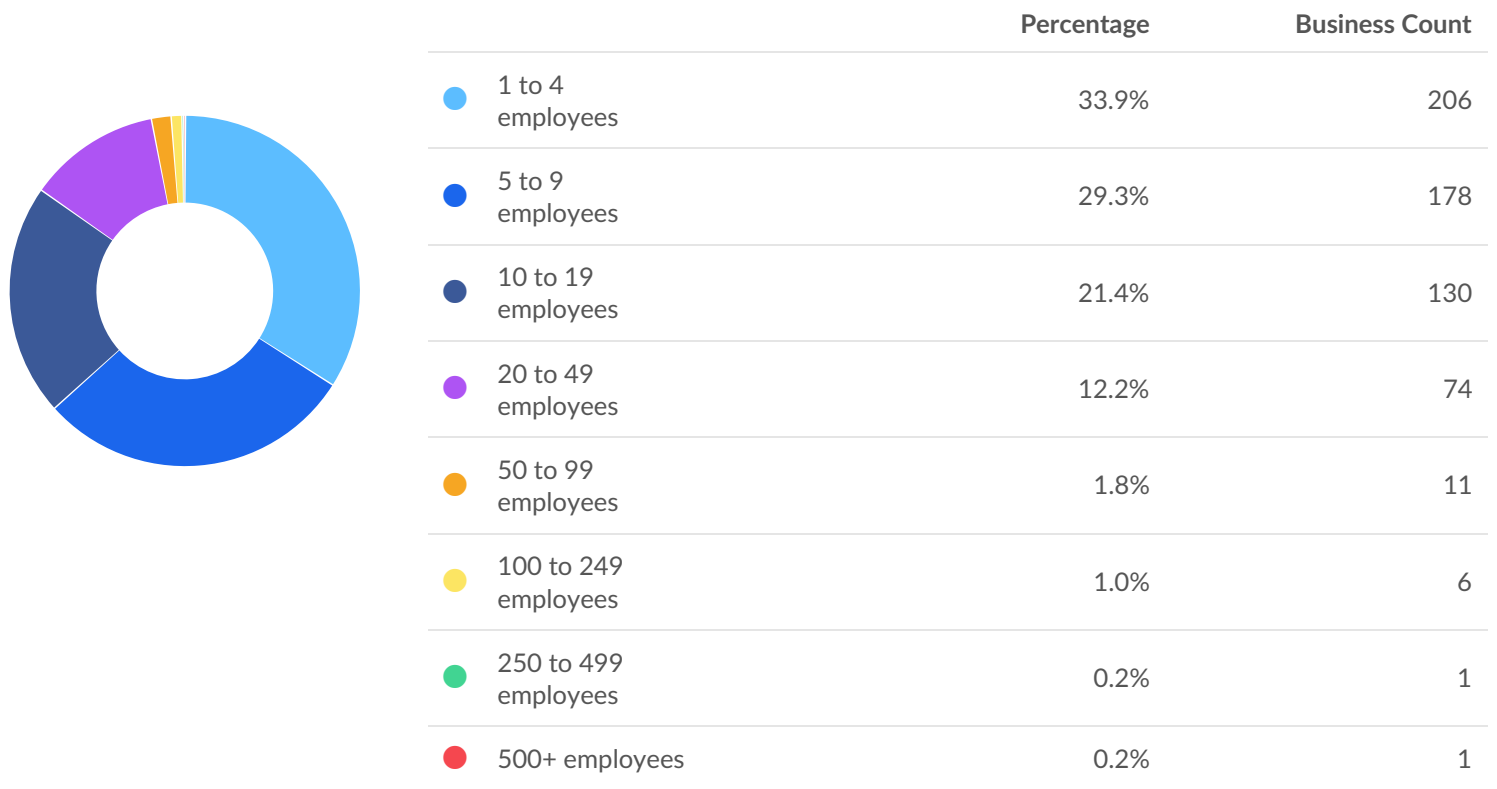

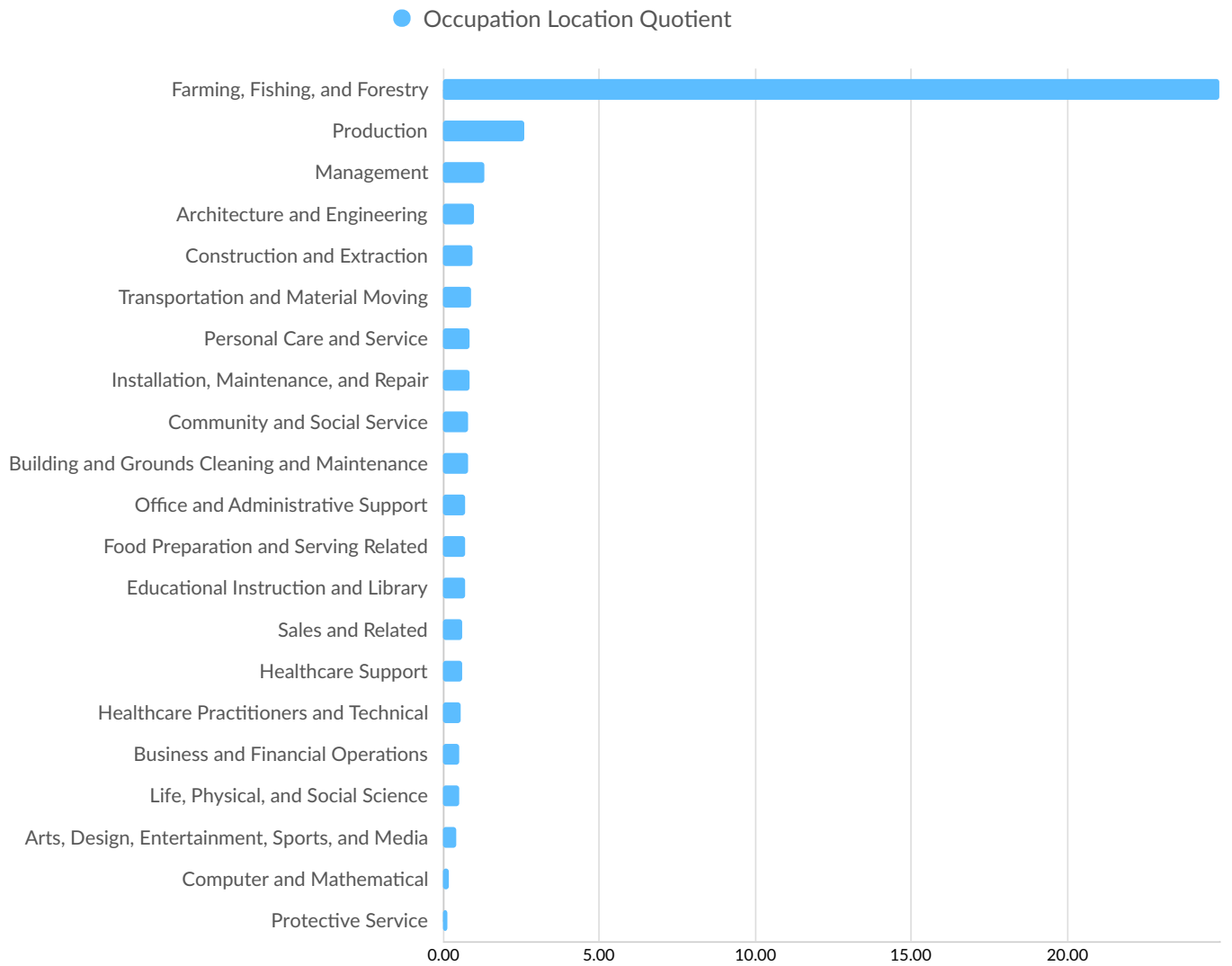

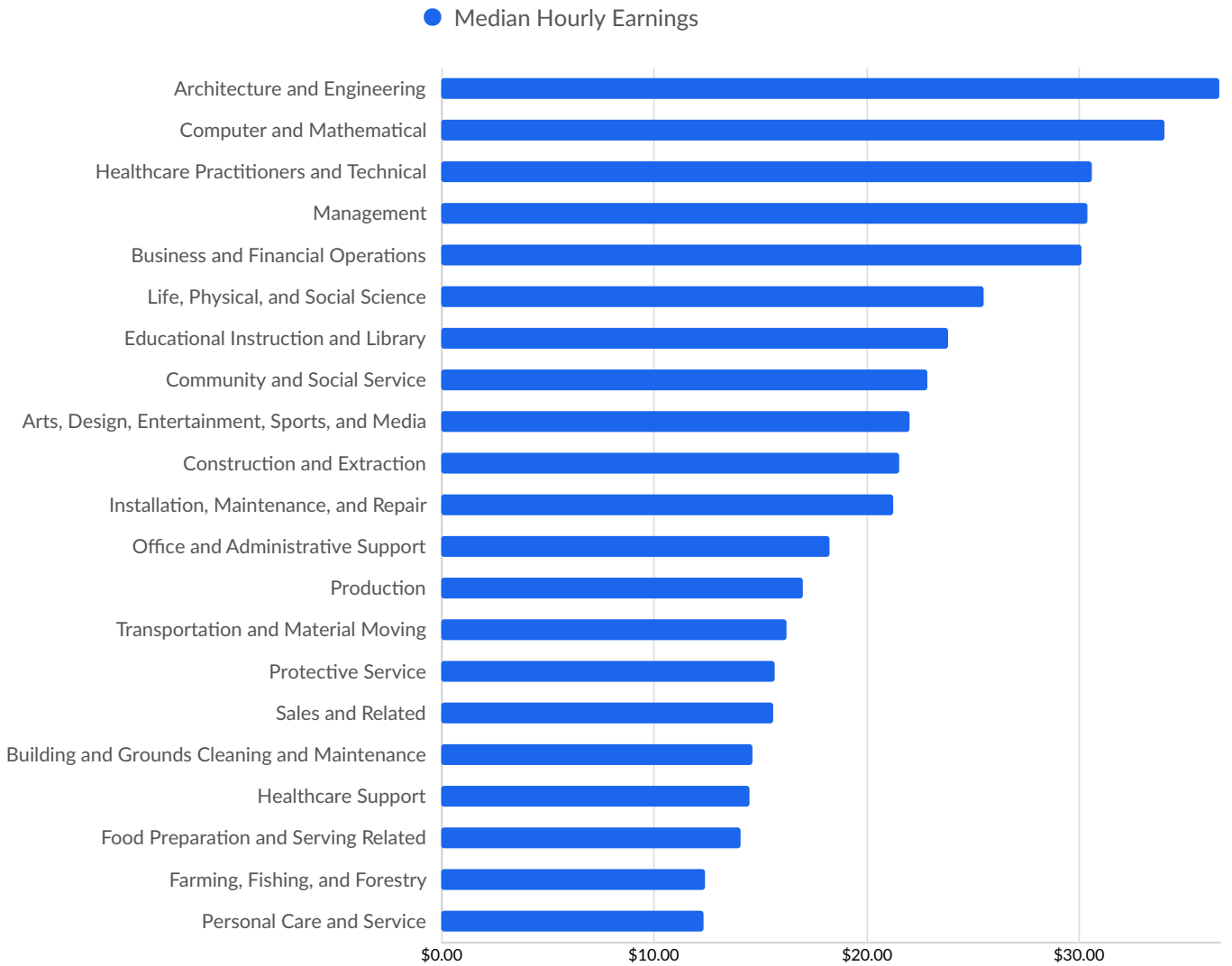
Top Growing Occupations
